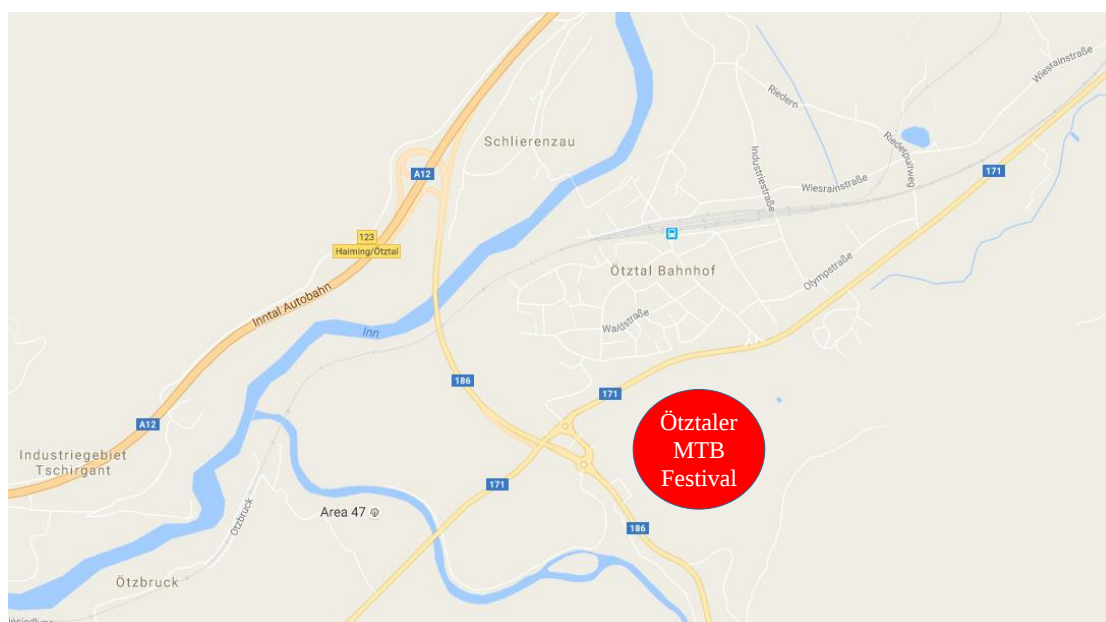


From Imst/Arlberg (Switzerland):
